Dr. Farah is the Director of the Center for Research on Bacteria and Bacteriophages Biology (CEPID B3), a network of 21 research laboratories in the state of São Paulo whose mission is to develop cutting-edge basic research on molecular mechanisms of paramount importance for understanding reproduction, multicellular behavior, competition, colonization, and interactions of bacteria with their eukaryotic hosts and their main predators, bacteriophages.
