## **Guidelines for abstract submission**

Abstract should be structured, according to the abstract template, and with the following sections:

#### 1. Title

The title should be clear and informative, representing the work content. It should not exceed 150 characters (including spaces).

#### 2. Authors

The abstract should include the first and last name of all authors, without academic degrees. Presenting and corresponding authors should be indicated.

### 3. Affiliations

Institutions directly involved in the work should be mentioned (academic, scientific, professional or other institutions), by including the research unit, department, institution, city and country.

#### 4. Abstract

The abstract should be structured, concise and should convey the essential findings. **It may not exceed more than 200 words** (excluding title, authors and affiliations) and it should include the following topics:

- a) Background
- b) Aim(s)
- c) Methods
- d) Results
- e) Conclusions

## 5. Keywords

Three to five keywords should be included.

## 6. Acknowledgments

A short acknowledgements section can be included.

## 7. Funding

A description of the funding entities supporting this work should be included.

### 8. References

A short list of references can be included.
