Dr. Cláudia Almeida is a neuroscientist and a research group leader at NOVA Medical School in Lisbon. She holds a Biochemistry BSc (1999), MSc (2001), and Ph.D. (2007) in Neurosciences from the University of Lisbon. Her doctoral work at Cornell University in New York provided foundational knowledge in the pathogenesis of Alzheimer's disease (AD). As an EMBO and Marie Curie fellow at Institut Curie in Paris, Dr. Almeida specialized in cell biology. She later established an independent research group at NOVA in 2013. Dr. Almeida's research has focused on mechanisms of beta-amyloid production, endosomal dysfunction, and synapse loss in late-onset AD and aging.
